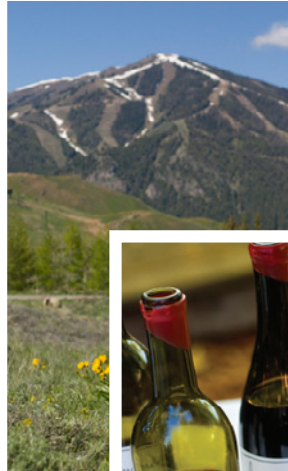

Sun Valley Harvest Festival - Friday, September 23rd through Sunday, September 25th will be a fun-filled weekend in Sun Valley during the most spectacular time of year.

Sun Valley Harvest Festival Restaurant Walk - Sponsored by Sysco Idaho, the Festival kicks-off at 5:00 pm on Friday night at the Ketchum Town Square with Frenchman's Gulch Winery and then continues as you wander through downtown Ketchum to sample food, wine and beer from participating restaurants and caterers. Admission \$25

Sun Valley Harvest Festival Cooking Demonstrations & Chef Presentations - Beginning at 9:00 am on Saturday at Carol's Dollar Mountain Lodge, 8 chefs will prepare local and regional foods while sharing information and their special cooking techniques. Join us to listen to an incredible line-up that includes Chefs Dave Martin and Sam Talbot from New York, Chef Melissa Costello from Los Angeles, Chef Clay Conley from Palm Beach, local Chefs Taite Pearson, Chris Kastner and Judith McQueen and Portland Chef Cathy Whims of Nostrana. Each Chef will give a one hour presentation followed by a sampling of their menu and a meet and greet opportunity. Admission is \$20.

The 2-hour event is free to the public and will spotlight what is truly an Idaho specialty, enjoying wonderful food in the backcountry as prepared by two Idaho River guides, using Dutch ovens and barbeques. Admission is free.
